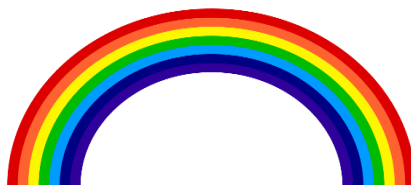

Dear Children, Parents and Guardians of Ysgol Gorslas.

I hope that everyone is keeping safe and well during this difficult and unsure time.

As we have started a new term, we are going to upload work onto the School [website](#) under the heading '[Information](#)'.

The work will be uploaded every fortnight starting from Monday April 27th until Sunday May 10th, and then another cycle will start on May 11th.

We ask if the children can upload their work on Hwb or on paper/books so that the teachers can track and mark the work. Instructions and videos for using Hwb and uploading work is on the school [website](#) under [Parents and Learners](#). We also ask if you can let us know either through the above e-mails or the mobile phone number if you need any ICT resources or resources such as paper/pencils etc.

All pupils have Hwb accounts but there is no expectation for the younger children in the Reception Class to upload their work on Hwb but they can do so if they wish. You could keep a 'scrap book' of their pictures/activities.
